



FUTURE BASKETBALL STARS CAMP COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

Future Basketball Stars is committed to ensuring the safety of the participants that attend our summer camp. After consulting with the CDC and American Camp Association, we have established the following protocols.

- FBS will have frequent communication prior to camp regarding campers health.
- Enrollment will be limited to 36 participants. There will be no on-site signups.
- Parents will be asked to sign a waiver upon arrival.
- Face coverings are recommended but not mandatory.
- Campers will need to bring own lunch, snack, and water bottle, and sunscreen.
- Drop off times will be staggered. Camp director will meet camper at car. Only camper will be allowed inside the gym.
- Temperature will be taken upon arrival of all staff and campers Any child temperature over 100.4 or adult temperature over 98.6 will not be allowed at camp
- Camper will sanitize hands upon arrival.
- Camper will be led to his/her “area” to place lunch, belongings. No outside food or drink will be available.
- Camper will be placed in a small group which they will stay for the entire camp
- The camp will utilize the outdoor court when possible.
- Camper will be given a basketball with their name on it to play with. This will be their basketball for the entire camp.
- Equipment will be disinfected frequently. Campers will wash hands/sanitize between activities.
- During activities, children will be encouraged to social distance, and eliminate “high fives” or any other physical actions.
- Only one camper will use restroom at a time, monitored by a coach
- For checkout, players will be walked outside to the outdoor court. They will be escorted to their car by a coach
- Any camper displaying symptoms will be removed from the camp

Staff Guidelines

- **FBS will pre-screen all staff before beginning of camp**
 - Staff will be trained on COVID transmission prevention and new cleaning protocols.
 - All staff will be asked to wash and/or sanitize hands upon entry and exit, and frequently during the day
 - All staff will be questioned about COVID-19 symptoms and exposure prior to entry and temperature checked.
 - All staff will be required to wear a mask during check-in/out of participants, interacting with parents/participants, during cleaning duties.
